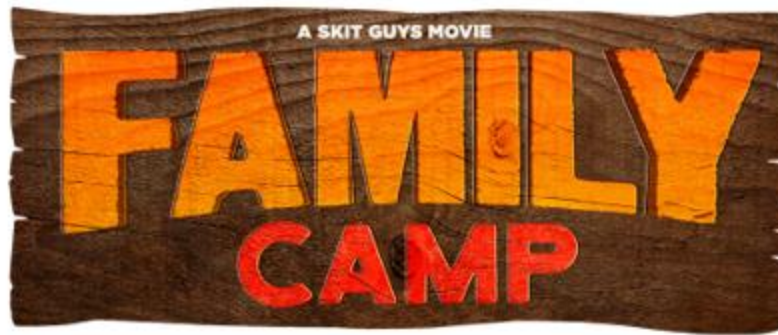

Lean on me

And brother I will lean on you

*There's nothing in the world that we can't get through**

For 30 years, Tommy Woodard and Eddie James have been best friends who enjoy making people laugh ... including each other. What started in high school drama classes and productions has grown into a calling: pointing people to a God who loves them, using humor to touch hearts of people from ages 8 to 80.

As The Skit Guys, Tommy and Eddie create funny and poignant short films that churches across the country (and around the world) utilize to help people connect more deeply with God. In addition, their online Bedtime Bible Stories are a humorous hit in homes and the duo continues to perform onstage at churches, conferences, and camps. They could never have known that when their youth pastor encouraged them to write and perform weekly skits for their high school group it would become their life's work.

"We just started doing skits for our youth group and that turned into doing skits for other youth groups," **Tommy Woodard** recalls. "You just kind of keep going down the road. It went from doing skits for other youth groups, to skits at camps and conferences, and then to making videos. There was always this dream. There was always that thing of, 'Yeah, but I want to be in movies. I want to really act.' But more than getting to do what I wanted to do, I really just wanted to be obedient."

Obedience to God's calling led Tommy and Eddie to become youth pastors. They both still serve in their local churches; Tommy is a teaching pastor in Oklahoma, while Eddie volunteers at his church in Texas. And their heart for people is what drives everything The Skit Guys do.

I've got a shoulder

You can laugh or you can cry

*There's never a moment that it's not true**

"We call what we do the three H's: humor, heart, and Him," **Eddie James** says. "Pretty much everything that we do is going to have humor because we believe humor breaks down walls for truth to enter. If you can laugh, you're going to be more apt to listen. And then you need to have something good to say, and we believe the Word of God is the best thing to talk about. We'll make you laugh, we'll make you think, and we'll point you to God. And hopefully at the same time, your heart's been moved."

"Everything we've done feels like it's all led to this," adds **Tommy Woodard**.

This is **FAMILY CAMP**, the first feature-length film from The Skit Guys, starring Tommy Woodard, Eddie James, Leigh-Allyn Baker (*Good Luck Charlie*), and Gigi Orsillo (*Sleeper Agent*) portraying two couples whose families are hilariously thrown in together for a week at a church camp.

“**FAMILY CAMP** is the story of two families who couldn’t be more different from one another who are forced to share the same lodging together for a week of family camp,” says **Brian Cates**, director and co-writer of the film. “If you can imagine the family from the *National Lampoon Vacation* movies meeting Ned Flanders and his family from *The Simpsons*, that’s **FAMILY CAMP**. Oh, and these two families have to bunk up in a yurt together for a week.”

A first-time feature-film director, Brian Cates has directed hundreds of short films for The Skit Guys. Producing **FAMILY CAMP** are industry veterans Darren Moorman (*Same Kind Of Different As Me*) and Trey Reynolds (*On The Line*), along with Jay Howver, The Skit Guys’ Chief Operations Officer, and line producer Justin Tolley (*War Room*).

Trey Reynolds, Vice President of Development and Production for Provident Films, says, “We immediately fell in love with the story and began the process of what would it look like for Provident to jump on board with The Skit Guys and bring **FAMILY CAMP** to life and to theaters.”

The idea for a movie with The Skit Guys existed long before the idea for **FAMILY CAMP**.

“They started out with an idea for a buddy comedy, Tommy and Eddie on a road trip,” says producer **Darren Moorman**. “But we wanted to make a movie that was broader for the entire family and included wives and kids for their characters. So we switched direction and landed with **FAMILY CAMP**, which is a script that has been a long time in the making, but these guys have done an amazing job writing it.”

Director Brian Cates and Rene Gutteridge, the head writer at Skit Guys Studios, crafted the screenplay.

“Brian really laid down a good initial script. From there we worked out all the characters, and the motivations, and the subplots. I counted 18 different drafts of this,” **Rene Gutteridge** says. “It’s been sitting on a piece of paper, and sort of inside my mind for a very long time. Sometimes it’s emotionally overwhelming to see these characters rise up out of the page, and have breath put into them, and suddenly be walking and talking.”

While the characters of Tommy Ackerman and Eddie Sanders were written for Tommy and Eddie, finding the right Grace and Victoria in Leigh-Allyn Baker and Gigi Orsillo took time.

“Leigh-Allyn Baker is amazing. She elevates all the performances around her,” director **Brian Cates** says. “And she makes me look like a better director because she comes every day with ideas of how she thinks the scenes should run. She adds so much texture and color to the scene

that isn't there on the page. And Gigi Orsillo is a joy and a light. She walked around set with the biggest heart, the biggest smile.”

“When I read the script, I thought there’s nothing like this in the faith-based world currently,” **Gigi Orsillo** says. “It’s something so new and so fresh and so funny, literally laugh-out-loud funny. I think it’s going to be so relatable to families—the comedy opens the door for God to touch the heart. I know that God put me here, and I’m so, so thankful to be a part of it.”

“This is probably the most fun I’ve had shooting a movie,” adds **Leigh-Allyn Baker**, best known for her lead role in the Disney Channel’s *Good Luck Charlie*. “These are my people. I found my people. I just want to work with them again now. I’m so thankful they hired me.”

FAMILY CAMP: On Set in Oklahoma

We show up, we love big

We pray hard, and we forgive

*Family is family**

As the sun rose over Central Oklahoma Camp’s 315 acres, Day 1 of the four-week **FAMILY CAMP** filming schedule commenced. All but two days of filming would be on the campgrounds in Guthrie, Okla. Even with a number of overnight shooting days, a joyful, fun-filled atmosphere was the standard from the start.

“One of the concerns I had about doing a feature film was whether our Skit Guys culture would translate,” says director **Brian Cates**. “What I mean by that is that we like to have fun. We like to enjoy ourselves. We like to encourage people and tell them what they’re good at and thank them for all their hard work. We take the time to do that and it makes a really fun place to work. And hopefully it instills a lot more pride in what we’re doing.

“We partnered with such great producers and great department heads who united with us in that vision. We met with the lead cast the weekend before filming started and we invited them into our vision of creating a family feeling. And that’s what we’ve been able to create here. That’s what makes Skit Guys sets different.”

This unique set culture was appreciated by the cast.

“I would have to say the cast and crew is just filled with loving people,” says **Mark Christopher Lawrence**, who plays Pastor Dave. “My first day on set, I remember this young man walked up and he was like, ‘Can I get you anything?’ And he was so nice about it and so joyful. A lot of times you go to a set and people are grumpy, like they don’t want to be there. And I’m like, ‘You have a job that people would die to do. This is way better than digging a ditch.’ Just looking at the people on the set, everybody is smiling and happy. Nobody is complaining and that’s great.”

“Working on a set that has been so full of energy and laughter has been amazing,” says **Cece Kelly**, who plays Hannah Ackerman. “There’s never a dull moment. Even in serious beats, everyone finds a way to put their own funny buttons on it.”

“It is such a joy because everyone really has their own defined role in the film and they bring their own humor,” says **Robert Amaya**, who plays Joel. “What you get is this beautiful mix of different types of comedy that come together to create just a barrel of laughs.”

A True Summer-Camp Experience

While uncredited in the cast list, Central Oklahoma Camp plays a starring role in **FAMILY CAMP**.

“The setting for **FAMILY CAMP** could not be better. I mean, it is tailor-made; every single set is contained in the camp,” says **Leigh-Allyn Baker**. “I mean, we really could have just all stayed there. I think it’s magical.”

From the camp’s natural beauty to the art department’s creation of a yurt that would be home to the Ackerman and Sanders families, everything on set had an intentional feel.

“We wanted **FAMILY CAMP** to feel like real camp. We didn’t want it to feel like a luxury retreat camp,” says director **Brian Cates**. “We wanted to evoke some feelings of nostalgia. We definitely didn’t want to bring a lot of new frills to camp.”

The real-life campgrounds provided the ideal setting for Robert Amaya, who plays Joel, the Camp Katokwah director.

“Filming **FAMILY CAMP** in a real camp setting makes it a lot more genuine and it’s a lot easier to feel the energy of what it’s like to be outdoors,” **Robert Amaya** says. “There’s a reason why camps exist and it’s because it’s serene. It’s nice.”

Family Is Family

It ain’t quiet, but we like it

*It ain’t perfect, but it’s worth it**

“One of the things I’ve always done as a producer is bring my family with me during production,” says producer **Darren Moorman**. “My wife Krista gets involved in community enrichment and building family on set. And my kids are around too. One of the things that was amazing about this film is not only did we bring our family, every producer on this movie brought their family. I think for the cast and crew it’s been a model of what it really looks like to make a movie about family while living it out.”

For Hollywood veteran Leigh-Allyn Baker, having her family on set was uniquely enjoyable.

“One of my favorite experiences about filming this movie is how inclusive it is of families. My whole family is here. Even my two dogs are here. My kids have been in the movie and they are

just riding high on life,” **Leigh-Allyn Baker** says. “Just to be on a set and feel safe with your children, running amuck with all the other kids, it really is a family-camp experience, not just on the page, but in life.”

In his first acting role, popular recording artist Rhett Walker plays the camp’s hipster worship leader. He also wrote the movie’s theme song: “Family Is Family” (along with Bryan Fowler and Jonathan Smith). As a father of four, he inherently knew how to connect his song to the heartbeat of the movie.

“It was like, ‘Man, what can we do that is all encompassing in this three-minute song that tells the story of the movie?’” **Rhett Walker** says. “And it just kind of hit us and we thought about the old saying, ‘family is family.’ So if you’re frustrated with your family, it’s ‘family is family.’ And in those moments where you realize they’re all you need, that Jesus gave you this family and y’all share that family name, it’s ‘family is family.’ We had a blast writing it just thinking of our own families. It’s a fun song to sing.”

While making a movie has long been a dream of Tommy Woodard and Eddie James, waiting until now has allowed The Skit Guys’ team to hone-in on the storytelling, purpose, and meaning of **FAMILY CAMP**.

“For close to 20 years, we’ve looked at how can we make a movie, a comedy, that could have humor, heart, and Him, but not feel like it’s a movie where different skits are just thrown together,” **Eddie James** says.

“I feel like there’s a real hole in the movie world when it comes to family comedies. I mean, this is what used to drive the box office,” says **Leigh-Allyn Baker**. “People now more than ever need to laugh. I’m really hopeful that people can laugh at this and laugh with us. And I really want to see movies where mom and dad get to go with the kids and with grandma and grandpa, and there’s something in it for everyone.”

A mother of two, Heather Land, who plays Cookie, also appreciates the impact the movie will have.

“I think anybody who loves good, clean humor will enjoy it. Families will love it,” **Heather Land** says. “I especially think that families who are struggling are going to benefit the most and pull the most from it.”

And 18-year-old Cece Kelly, who places Hannah Ackerman, thinks teens will enjoy the movie along with the rest of their family (even if they won't admit it).

"I would tell teenagers that this is a really fun movie that you may think you can't relate to, but then once you watch it you'll know, especially with Hannah, the feeling of, I didn't realize that growing up so fast could impact me so much," **Cece Kelly** says. "I think that it's a really great and fun movie to just laugh and have a great time while watching it."

A Family Comedy With Purpose

Thank You Jesus

We all share the family name

*We're all sons and daughters of the Father**

"**FAMILY CAMP** is really important for us at The Skit Guys, because we are all about comedy," says producer **Jay Howver**. "As a family, it's an important thing to be able to laugh together. With **FAMILY CAMP**, we are using humor to break down walls so that truth can enter. We want it to be a jumping off point that families can really use it as a tool to grow together."

Adds director **Brian Cates**, "There aren't a lot of really funny family comedies that also point you to God. Getting the most important relationship right helps you get the most precious relationships in your life right. Once we yield to God in our lives, we start to get focused on what our relationship with our spouse looks like, what our relationships with our kids look like. That's really the message of **FAMILY CAMP** and it's a message the world needs to hear. Our world needs a message of hope, of love, and of unity and it starts at the family."

For years, The Skit Guys have connected deeply with their audiences. Now, for the first time, Tommy and Eddie will be on the big screen together. It's a natural next step for these lifelong friends.

"People who see us want to be a part of our friendship, and they should because everyone should have a friend that you love to be with," **Tommy Woodard** says. "Whether we're in the car driving to a gig, whether we're making a mini movie or now whether we're making a feature film, it is literally just two friends doing what we've done since high school."

"Doing it on this level and making a movie, while there's more pressure, it's the same thing we've been doing for more than 30 years. It's just an extension of our friendship. The weird thing is, I have to not like Eddie in this movie. His character is the bane of my existence in **FAMILY CAMP**. That's the challenge, but it's so fun."

When it opens in theaters, families are sure to enjoy the humor, the heart, and the Him at the fabric of **FAMILY CAMP** ... and The Skit Guys.

"I cannot think of a better time for a comedy like this. People are going to laugh. And as soon as the movie's over, there are going to be conversations," **Eddie James** says. "And those

conversations will point to God. The conversations point to the inner workings of who we are as people. And I love that. I'll do that every day of my life until God says, 'You're done.'"

CHARACTER BIOS

Tommy Ackerman

Tommy Woodard, one half of The Skit Guys, plays Tommy, who feels more at home on the golf course closing a deal than he does at home with his wife and two kids. When his wife Grace signs up the family for a week at family camp, Tommy goes in kicking and screaming. And then it gets worse—he learns he and his family will be sharing a yurt with the “perfect” family of his new archnemesis Eddie Sanders!

Tommy Woodard: “Tommy Ackerman is always climbing the ladder. I mean, his big distraction is the next promotion. And he makes these hollow promises to his family that, ‘Once I get this next promotion, we’ll do this and this.’ But what happens is, every time he gets the next promotion, he sees another one that’s just around the corner. And so that keeps him from being the dad and the husband that he could be. You see glimpses of who he could be, but he doesn’t even realize that’s who he wants to be.”

Eddie Sanders

Eddie James, one half of The Skit Guys, plays Eddie—someone you likely know if you’ve ever been to church. His glass isn’t half full; it’s overflowing with blessings! The harmonica-playing chiropractor and his family are the two-time defending champions of the Katokwah Cup and he plans to do whatever it takes to make it a threepeat!

Eddie James: “What I love about Eddie Sanders is he’s full of ebullience. He’s full of this drive that he really wants people to smile, he really wants people to be happy. He really thinks he’s a moment catcher and he’s making moments for everybody. And that’s really fun to play. And with him being a believer, I think he truly feels he is living his best life. He’s a survivor but towards the end of this movie he realizes, ‘I don’t want to survive anymore. I want to live.’”

Grace Ackerman

Veteran comedic actor **Leigh-Allyn Baker** plays Grace, who loves her family just as they are ... but she’s willing to do whatever it takes to make them, well, better. Between her husband’s twin passions of work and golf, her 16-year-old daughter acting like she’s 25, and her younger son’s awkward brilliance, it would take a miracle to turn things around for the Ackermans.

Leigh-Allyn Baker: “To bring Grace to life and to really emphasize the struggles, I have to bring out the fun as well, because we’re not one-dimensional people. Even at a funeral, there’s somebody who’s going to laugh, right? I just wanted to bring some energy to her and amp her up in good scenes so in the scenes where she’s really rocked by her reality, it makes a bigger impact. I feel like Grace is really open to Tommy meeting her halfway. She’s very open to communicating and working together.”

Victoria Sanders

Gigi Orsillo, who took a break from acting to raise her three girls, plays Victoria. And while the Sanders are seemingly an ideal family, things aren’t always what they appear on the outside.

Thankfully, Victoria has a great sense of humor, a strong faith, and a core strength to help her persevere to make things better.

Gigi Orsillo: “Victoria is this fun, family-loving woman. She wants the best for her family. She wants the best for her marriage. And her feistiness and her voice have kind of been muted in her marriage. She’s feeling a bit invisible in her marriage and in her family. And I think that a lot of women feel that way. It’s just an easy rhythm to get into. I love that she finds her voice, because God puts two people in a marriage for a reason, and two is better than one.”

Hannah Ackerman

Up-and-coming actor **Cece Kelly** plays teenage Hannah. While she rarely sees eye-to-eye with her parents, she does stand by her dad when he looks for any way out of going to family camp! Hannah quickly changes her tune, however, when the cutest boy at camp takes a liking to her ... much to her mother’s chagrin.

Cece Kelly: “Hannah is a 16-year-old girl that feels like she’s probably 25. She feels like she is very mature and wants to be really independent. But as she is at camp, she realizes that she actually needs her family way more than she thought she did. I connected to Hannah, knowing what it feels like to want to be older and want to be grown up and then realizing that you still need your family and you’re always going to need them.”

Joel

Robert Amaya, best-known for his role as Javier in the Kendrick Brothers’ **Courageous**, plays Joel, the director of Camp Katokwah. Joel has worked at camp for as long as anyone can remember. A happy bachelor, he does all he can to steer clear of Cookie, who has her eyes on him.

Robert Amaya: “Joel is this bubbly guy. He actually reminds me a lot of the youth pastors I had. They would sometimes lay down those corny dad jokes and try to be cool. 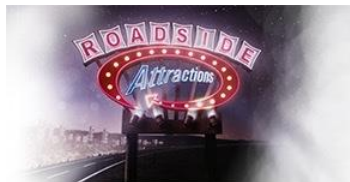

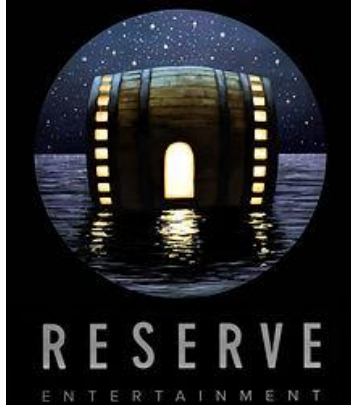
